

AIAM Position Statement on Dangerous Dogs

The Australian Institute of Animal Management recognises there are dogs in the community that show inappropriate dangerous behaviour.

The Institute believes that these dogs must be managed to ensure community safety.

The Institute encourages all levels of government to implement legislative and regulatory systems that assess, declare and manage dogs that show signs of inappropriate dangerous behaviour.
